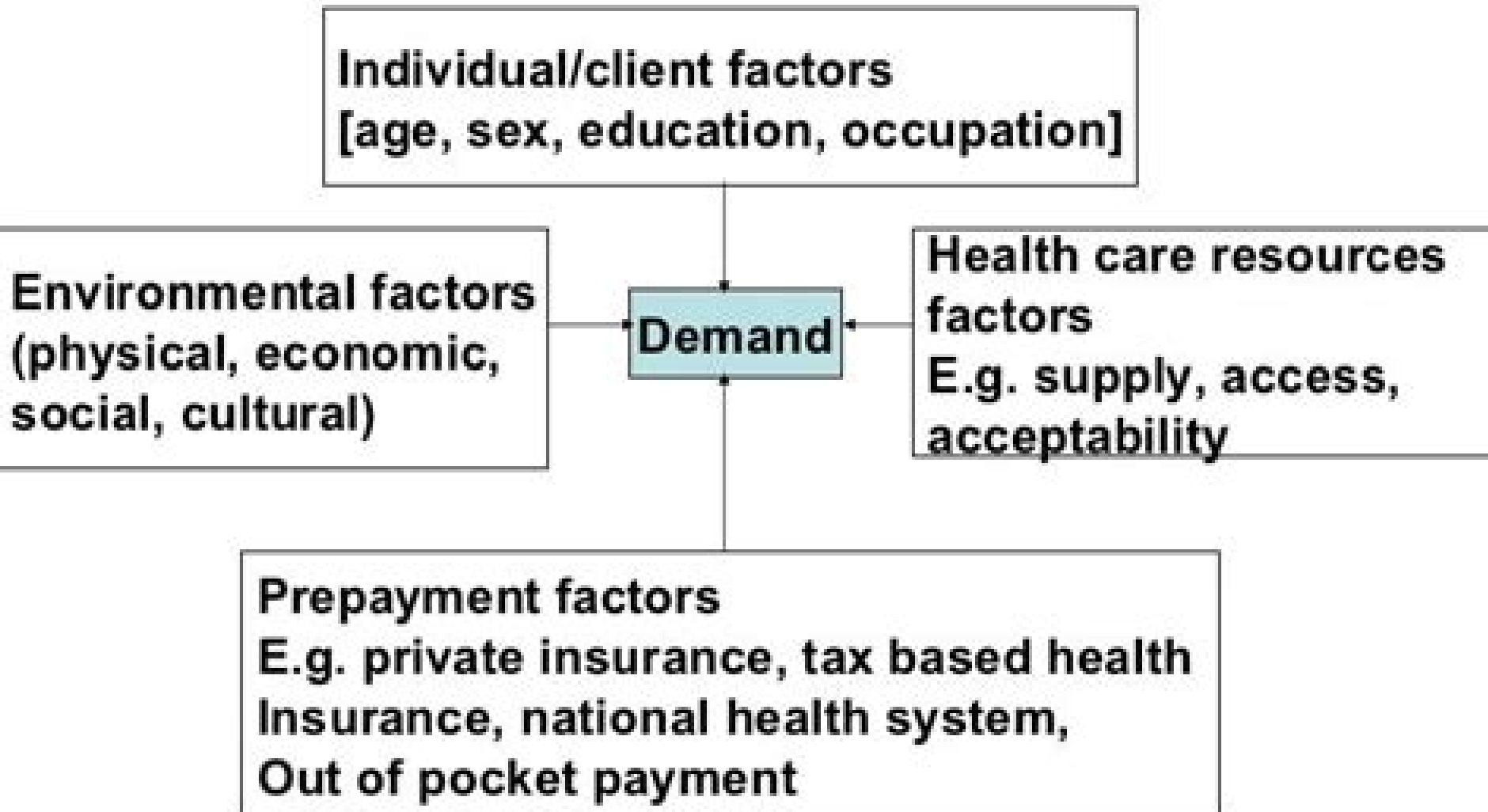

The time path for medical care demand suggests the change in health rather than the state of health drives increasing demand, and that price sensitivity declines over time. I test the central hypothesis that the change in health is significant using the first 14 waves of the British Household Panel Survey (BHPS).
