

- Language disorders are associated with other kinds of disabilities. Coexist with other disabilities.

- **EDD**

- Intellectual disabilities:

- Can be acquired by a genetic disorder.
 - Prenatal factors (e.g., malnutrition, maternal anoxia, generalized trauma, fetal anomalies
 - Post-birth (e.g., TBI, cerebral abnormalities, lead poisoning).
 - Typically developmental patterns but need to be delayed.
 - Semantic difficulties (smaller vocabulary).
 - Difficulty interacting with others.

- **AUTD**

- Language problems associated: echolalia, perseveration, difficulties in comprehension, use of short phrases, social communication problems, etc.

- **TBI**

- Can be classified into two subgroups.
 - TBI and or CP
 - TBI-Focal injury to the brain.
 - Characterized by: Comprehension problems, word retrieval difficulty, syntactic problems, reduced speed of processing, difficulty reasoning, organization, and memory, etc.

- **CP**

- NIS is affected.
 - Muscular incoordination and associated problems.

- **3. Children with Language Problems: Associated with Physical and Social Environmental Factors**

- Language disorders can be related to environmental factors such as poverty, neglect or abuse, alcohol, drug exposure in utero, and AEDDs.
- **LOW INCOME** is not equal to **INTELLIGENCE**. However, socioeconomic status is vital for language development.
- Limited access to resources.
- Correlation between education and income level.
 - Opportunities for literacy may not be as prominent.
 - Lack of enriching experiences.
 - Lack of toys and books to stimulate language development.
- Can be related to Neglect/Abuse.
- Parental drug and Alcohol Abuse.
