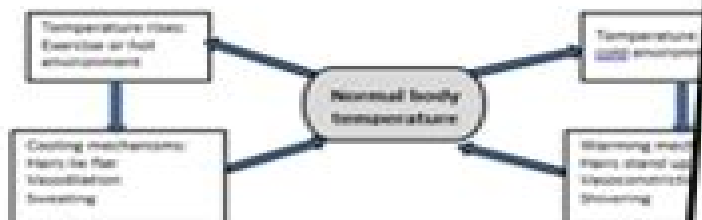


	When you're too hot	When you're too cold
1. Hairs	Hairs on the skin lie flat, so that heat can escape more easily.	Hairs stand up and trap warm air, which insulates the body and helps to keep the heat in. Tiny muscles in the skin can quickly pull the hairs upright to reduce heat loss.
2. Sweat glands	Sweat glands secrete sweat onto the skin surface. The evaporation of sweat takes heat from the skin.	No sweat released.
3. Blood vessels	The arteries that take blood to the skin get wider (called vasodilation). More blood flows close to the surface of the skin, where it can lose heat to the air.	The arteries that take blood get narrower (called vasoconstriction). Less blood flows to the surface of the skin, so more heat is kept in.

- As well as the skin, your **muscles** also receive nerve impulses from the brain when they respond by **shivering**, which warms you up because the movement of the muscles produces heat energy.

These control mechanisms stop automatically when the core body temperature returns to normal.

The DNA molecule and base pairs

The rings of the DNA ladder are made up of **sugars** connected to each other. It is the **bases** of the bases that carries the actual genetic code.

There are 4 different base molecules. Each is usually known by the first letter of its name:

Adenine (A), Cytosine (C), Guanine (G), Thymine (T)

The way the bases join up in pairs is fixed. A and T always join together, and C and G always join together.

These are called **complementary base pairs**.

So, if the sequence of bases on one side of the DNA molecule is known, the sequence on the other side will be:

3' T A C G C 5'

The order of the bases controls the type of protein that the cell makes. These proteins give organisms their characteristics.

Chromosomes and genes

Chromosomes are chromosomes in our body cells, arranged in 23 pairs. When stained and viewed under a microscope, they look like this:

We inherit one chromosome of each pair from our mother and one from our father.

Genes (parts of chromosomes) control the development of an organism.

When the nucleus of the egg and the sperm fuse together in fertilisation, the new cell has the full set of chromosomes (46).



- Remember that all the pairs are identical except for the 23rd pair. These are the sex chromosomes. The female has 2X chromosomes and the male has 1X and 1Y chromosome.

All normal cells produced by a human body have an X chromosome.

In the case of sperm, however, half the sperm carry an X and half carry a Y.

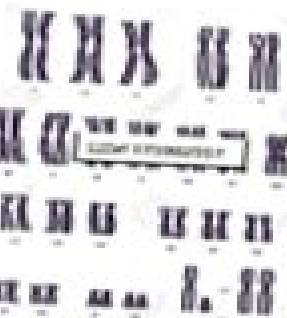
A human body is not a diploid organism. It is formed by a sperm and an egg. The body cell has a full set of chromosomes (46). The body cell has a full set of chromosomes (46).

Since we inherit our particular characteristics from our parents through the egg and sperm, we also inherit the characteristics coded for by the genes on these chromosomes.

Mutations

Body cells divide to make other body cells and to make gametes. Sometimes when cells are dividing there is a change in the order of the bases in a gene.
