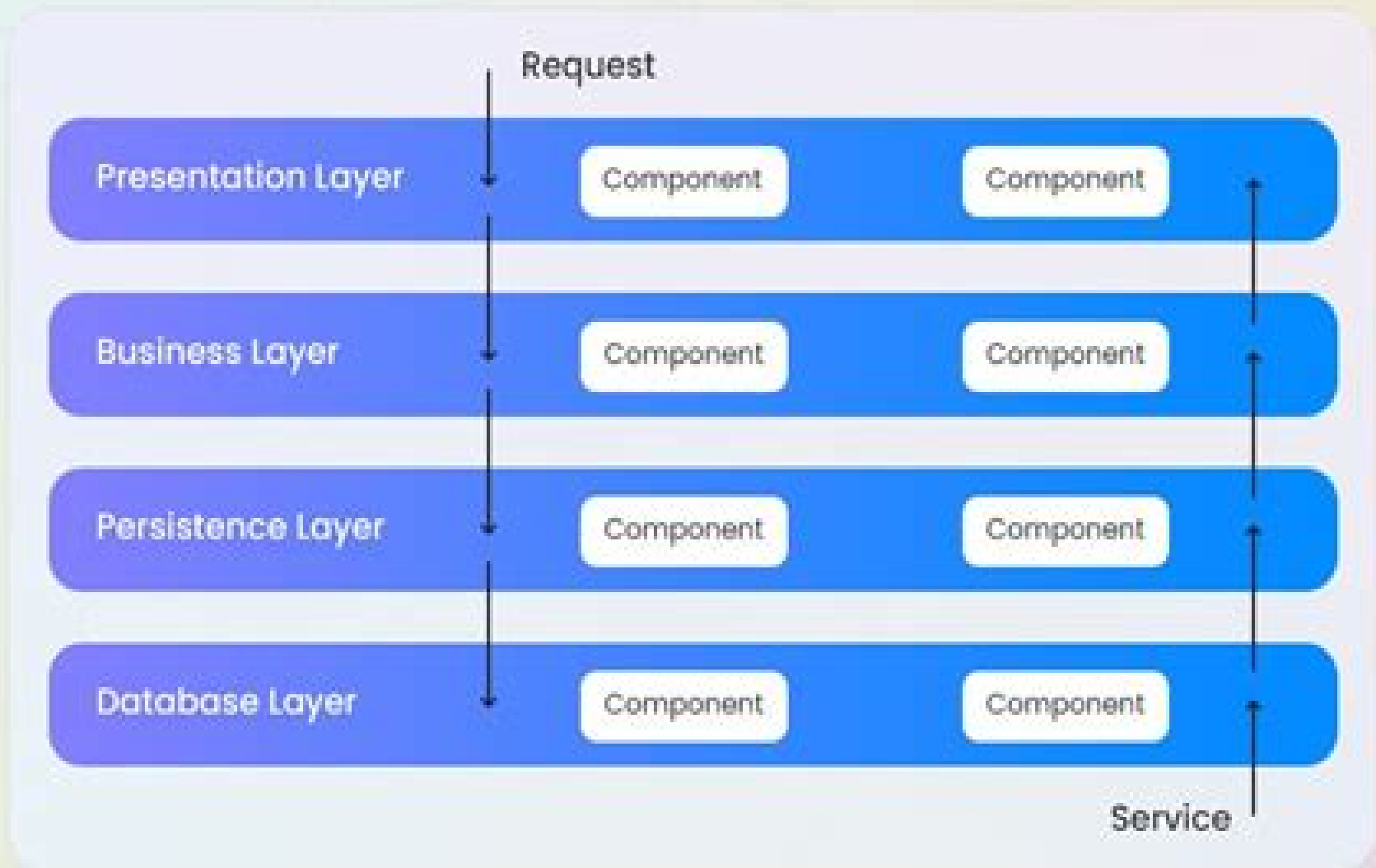

Quality of Software Architectures Models and Architectures Steffen Becker, Frantisek Plasil, Ralf H. Reussner, 2008-10-07. Models are used in all kinds of engineering disciplines to abstract from the various details of the modelled entity in order to focus on a specific aspect. Like a blueprint in civil engineering, a software architecture provides an abstraction from the full software system's complexity. It allows software designers to get an overview on the system under development and to analyze its properties. In this sense, models are the foundation needed for software development to become a true engineering discipline. Especially when reasoning on a software system's extra functional properties, its software architecture carries the necessary information for early design time analyses. Quality of Software Architectures and Software Quality Ralf H. Reussner, Johannes Mayer, Judith A. Stafford, Sven Overhage, Steffen Becker, Patrick J. Schroeder, 2005-09-09. This book constitutes the joint refereed proceedings of two colocated events: the First International Conference on the Quality of Software Architectures (QoSA 2005) and the Second International Workshop on Software Quality (SOQUA 2005) held in Erfurt, Germany, in September 2005. The 18 revised full papers presented were carefully reviewed and selected from 48 submissions.
