

In contrast, people in rich countries are almost all well identified from birth. Many of these programs use digital biometric identification technology that distinguish physical or behavioral features such as fingerprints or iris scans to help leapfrog traditional paper-based identity systems. The technology cannot do everything, but recent advances enable it to be used far more accurately than previously to provide identification who are you and authentication are you who you claim to be. Technology costs are falling rapidly and it is now possible to ensure unique identity in populations of at least several hundred million with little error. This paper surveys 160 cases where biometric identification has been used for economic, political and social purposes in developing countries. About half of these cases have been supported by donors. Recognizing the need for more rigorous assessments and more open data on performance, the paper draws some conclusions about identification and development and the use of biometric technology. Some cases suggest large returns to its use with potential gains in inclusion, efficiency and governance. In others, costly technology has been ineffective or combined with the formalization of identity has increased the risk of exclusion. One primary conclusion is that identification should be considered as a component of development policy rather than being seen as just a cost on a program by program basis. Within such a strategic framework, countries and donors can work to close the identification gap and in the process improve both inclusion and the efficiency of many programs.
