Science	Bird Watching Sorting Feathers	Children will create their own binoculars to take on a bird watching walk later in the day. Real binoculars along with books and photos of birds will be set out on a table close by the window for children to explore. A variety of colors of feathers will be provided in a sorting tray for children to play with and practice sorting by color. 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
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
