Did you know that before the late 1800s when was no standard time? This meant the length of an hour could be a day longer and when it should start, in different towns and in different countries. This didn't help in time travel because the train didn't necessarily when people were making patterns and times and by the time that went the intended destination longer and go to waste because it was lost by train. Having a standard measure of time became more important. For example, if a train was leaving the city by train, then when someone said in another town the train it was 10:30 am, then the train conductor thought it was 3:0:30 am the passenger could these putting his things on the train, and being able to call the other town.

To solve this problem in October of 1884, Chester A. Arthur, the President of the United States, held a conference in Washington D.C. that would set a standard time for the entire world. It was decided at the conference that a town in England called Greenwich would be the base of time for the world and all other countries would have their time zones off of how far they were from Greenwich. There was one challenge to standardizing time, and that was communicating the time with the world. For this, the invention of the radio was a great help. On that day in 1884 the Greenwich time signal was broadcast on the radio for the first time. This was a series of tones at the beginning of the hour that let everyone listening to the radio, put their clocks to the same time.
