

# How to write a book in 30 days



## 1. Set attainable goals

Work out your average word count per minute, times 60 for what you can attain hourly.

## 2. Set realistic daily targets

How many hours can you write per day? Factor in breaks and distractions.

## 3. Keep time for different tasks

Split writing time into outlining, drafting, and other processes. Varied work stays more fun.

## 4. Motivate using rewards

Give yourself a simple reward for each writing milestone to keep up motivation.

## 5. Make it a game

Don't apply unnecessary pressure that could decrease motivation - treat it as a game.

## 6. Write 'drunk'

Give yourself the freedom to play and be giddy with words and ideas - edit later.

## 7. Cheat and use shorthand

Use summary form, add notes where you don't have it all worked out to keep momentum.

## 8. Celebrate progress

Whether or not you finish in 30 days, you'll have something to develop and key learnings.
