The five vital points of contact are the points of contact between the hands and the body. They are the points of contact between the hands and the body.

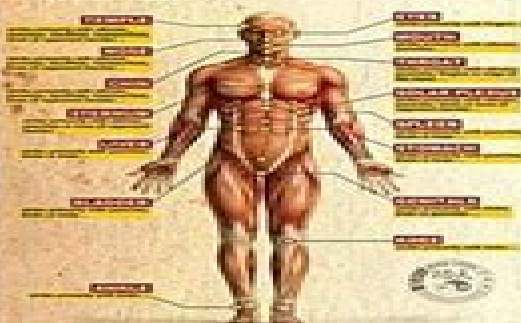
5. Staggering

Staggering is the principle of moving in a staggered way. It is the principle of moving in a staggered way.

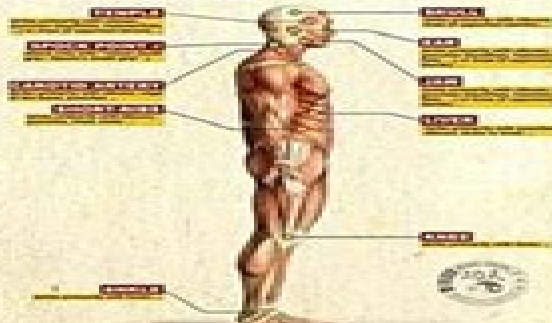

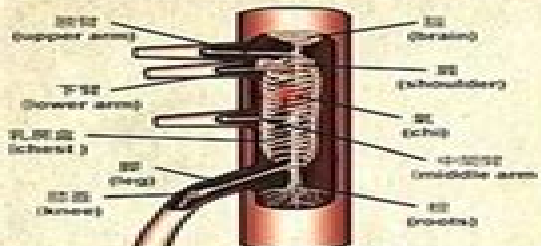

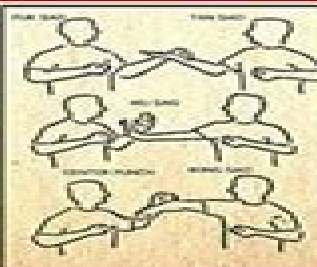
