

FUNCTIONAL INDEPENDENCE MEASURE FOR CHILDREN (WEEFIM)

It was developed for use with children from 6 months to 7 years and older, which is responsible for evaluating functionality and independence in ADL. The items it contemplates are the following:

- To eat
- B.- Personal Cleanliness
- C.- Bathe
- D.- Dressing – Upper body
- E.- Dressing – Lower body
- F.- Use the bathroom
- G.- Bladder management (presents 2 levels)
- H.- Management of the intestine (presents 2 levels)
- I.- Chair transfers, wheelchair
- J.- Toilet transfers
- K.- Transfers to the bathtub or shower
- L.- Locomotion walking, wheelchair, crawling. (describe the 3 parts)
- M.- Stair Locomotion
- N.- Comprehension
- O.- Expression
- P.- Social Interaction
- Q.- Troubleshooting

Each of these items is divided into two parts within the classification which can be, "No helper; which classifies into "Complete Independence" "Modified Independence". Or also in "Assistant" which is classified as "Supervision or Preparation", "Minimum Contact Help", "Moderate Help", "Maximum Help", "Total Help".

TO: EAT

It includes the use of appropriate utensils to bring food to the mouth, sucking, biting, chewing and swallowing.

NOT HELPER

7 Complete independence - The child eats from a plate, while managing all food consistencies, and drinks from a cup or glass with food presented in the usual way on a table or tray. The child uses a spoon or fork to bring food to the mouth; food is chewed and swallowed. Run safely.

6 Modified Independence - The child requires an adaptation or assistive device such as a long straw; a fork-spoon, or a plate holder; requires more than a reasonable time to eat, or requires modification of the consistency of the food or blended food, or there are considerations regarding its safety. If the child depends in part on other forms of feeding, such as parenteral or gastronomic feeding, then he/she performs his/her feedings himself/herself.

ASSISTANT

5 Supervision or Preparation - The child requires supervision (e.g., standing by, directing, or persuading) or preparation (application of orthoses); feeding means although it does not need to be present during feeding.

4 Minimal contact assistance - Child performs the majority (75% or more) of eating tasks.
3 Moderate Help - The child performs half or more (50% to 74%) of the eating tasks.

2 Maximum Assistance - Child performs less than half (25% to 49%) of tasks when eating solid food, finger foods, or holding a bottle, but requires maximum assistance.

1 Full Assistance - The child performs little or none (less than 25%) of the tasks of bottle-feeding or breastfeeding within a reasonable amount of time, but requires full assistance, or the
