involvements with marriage and draws lessons that serve as cautionary tales for today s marriage rights movements While be careful what you wish for is a prominent theme they also teach us how the rights bearing subject is inevitably shaped by the very rights they bear often in ways that reinforce racialized gender norms and stereotypes Franke further illuminates how the racialization of same sex marriage has redounded to the benefit of the gay rights movement while contributing to the ongoing subordination of people of color and the diminishing reproductive rights of women Like same sex couples today freed African American men and women experienced a shift in status from outlaws to in laws from living outside the law to finding their private lives organized by law and state licensure Their experiences teach us the potential and the perils of
