S. - China Relations** Ifay Chang, 2020-04-11 This is the sixth book about current events happening between the US and China The US and China both have made significant changes in their foreign policies towards each other and towards the rest of the world China was forced into isolation in most part of 20th century until the US adopted the Nixon Kissinger doctrine Then China was embraced back into the world by the US This change of policy by the US was motivated by the goal confining the Soviet Union and the spread of communism but it has given China which had long parted her way with the Soviet Union the opportunity to develop and grow her economy in her own way in an amazing pace to become the number two economy in the world with just a little over three decades of time The US touted isolationism in her founding era but essentially interpreted and practiced isolationism in her foreign policy to her advantage The US eventually emerged as a super power surpassing the European nations by balancing their power In relative sense the US economy once peaked at 40% of the world economy has been reduced to less than half of the current world economy owing to the faster pace of economic growth in Asian countries especially that of China Hence the US felt the stress from maintaining her global leader position up keeping her military and economic presence all over the world China's rapid rise and her successful engagement in the global affairs are perceived as a threat by the US The above background can explain why the US has initiated a trade war against China and has stirred up several confrontational issues such as navigation right in South China Sea Taiwan status North Korea nuclear threat trade imbalance technology competition etc etc China on the other hand has been focusing on lifting her citizens above poverty and eagerly pursuing globalism by proposing an ambitious global economic development program named Belt and Road Initiative BRI which calls for collaborative economic

development along a land road and a sea belt from Asia to Europe via central Asia and Africa and Pacific to Atlantic through Indian Ocean This is a very different kind of globalism from the one led by the U S This book presents essays on various topics and different issues confronting the U S and China with the hope that rational thinking will take place to guide the U S China relations back to collaboration and engagement from isolation or confrontation for their mutual benefits and world prosperity

**US-China Issues - Trade +++** Ifay F Chang,2019-03-28 The relationship between the two great nations the U S and China took an almost about face turn in recent years from engaging China into the world to targeting China as an enemy The Trump Administration with his handpicked team of staff has made the U S China Policy even more uncertain than the Obama Administration This is partly due to the new style of Presidency Mr Donald Trump has brought to the White House and partly due to the rapid rise in economic power China has exhibited with her net buying power reaching the number one position in the world China maintains a trade surplus with nearly all her trading partners in the world except a handful of countries The U S has a trade deficit in goods with China over 300 Billion annually since 2012 The US China relation was somewhat warm in 2017 with a Trump Xi summit at Mar a Lago Florida in March and Trump's State visit to China in November plus China's

agreeing to buy more US goods But in 2018 the Trump Administration initiated a tariff war starting with a global safeguard tariff in February placing 30% tariff on solar panels and 20% on washing machines then 25% tariff on all steel imports and 10% on all aluminum imports in March From then on to 2019 China reciprocated and the US escalated threatening to apply tariffs to thousands of items up to US 200 Billion in value making trade negotiations lingering on The US China conflict is not limited in trade as evidenced by other events such as US applying sanctions to Chinese technology corporations examples like Huawei and ZTE and accusing China unfairly acquiring technologies to upgrade her manufacturing capability which China touted as China Manufacturer 2025 The author has been studying the US China relations from a historical perspective and closely monitoring current events concerning the two countries through the mainstream media as well as the organic views expressed in Internet blogs and news circulations This book is his fifth publications in the book series of Mainstream and Organic Views focusing on US China issues from trade to other conflicts
