

#### 4. Esophagus

- muscular tube
- connects the pharynx to the stomach.
- Peristaltic occurs.
  - involuntary wave-like muscle contractions that move food along the digestive tract
- Partially digested food is called the **bolus**.



#### 5. The Stomach

- temporary storage of food, typically 2-4 hours
- mechanical and chemical digestion occur here.
- Secretes gastric juice
- pH range 1.5 - 3.0
- Protein digestion occurs here.
- Broken down food is a thick liquid mixture called **chyme**.



#### 6. Small intestine


- Chemical digestion is completed here.
- nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream.
  - 5-6 hours for absorption.
- Contains **liver**.
  - Little finger that transports nutrients into the bloodstream.



#### 7. Accessory Organs


##### a) Gall Bladder

- holds the bile, produced by Liver
- breaks down fats into smaller fat droplets.



##### b) Pancreas

- Secretes enzymes to break down ALL compounds of life (carbohydrates, proteins, nucleic acids and fats).
- neutralizes the acidity of the chyme.
