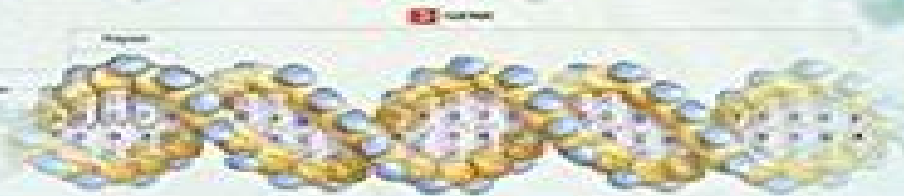

What is DNA?

DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) contains the instructions for building and running a cell. It is a long, thin, double-stranded molecule that is coiled into a spiral shape. The DNA molecule is made of two strands, one of which is the sugar-phosphate backbone and the other is the nitrogenous base. The sugar-phosphate backbone is made of deoxyribose sugar and phosphate groups. The nitrogenous base is made of a purine or pyrimidine ring. The purine ring is made of two fused rings, and the pyrimidine ring is made of one ring. The purine ring is found in the DNA molecule, and the pyrimidine ring is found in the RNA molecule.

Where is DNA found?

DNA is found in the nucleus of a cell. The nucleus is a large, spherical structure that contains the DNA molecule.
