

The Tale of the Mandarins' Daughters

Prerequisite:

This lesson will give students a solid basis of Japanese culture during the time of the Samurai.

Target Length: Length: 1st & 2nd grade

Essential Questions:

1. What are parts of the Samurai code of behavior?
2. What are some key events the culture of this time period found important?

Rationale:

Students will be introduced to some aspects of the Japanese culture during the time of the Samurai and Samurai. They will hopefully help balance out the views of the aggressive Samurai warriors shown in popular culture.

Materials:

The book *The Tale of the Mandarins' Daughters* by Katherine Paterson
Introduction to Bushido culture book
Writing and drawing implements

Activities:

Time: 1 class period

1. The class will create a KWL chart on what they know about Samurai's, Samurai and Japanese culture during 1592-1776.
2. The teacher will then read *The Tale of the Mandarins' Daughters* outlined in the class.
3. While reading, discuss the clothes the people in the story are wearing and the writing (brushes used as writing material, Mandarins use tea tree, watercolor paper lanterns).
4. Then read the Introduction to Bushido (or give a copy to the class to read).

Assessment:

Have students fill individual worksheets during 4 days. Assessment in the book demonstrated some aspect of the "Way of the Warrior".

Extension:

They will take an entire class period or more. Have students create their own story that illustrated a Samurai following the "Way of the Warrior". They can illustrate it and share with the class. Discuss that Shinto culture (Shintoism is a type of belief that almost everything natural had some spirit in it that could help people like the Shinto and that should be an important part of their story. Share the stories with the class.
