500 BC

Ancient authors shared concerns of environmental degradation by humans, and suggested less harmful practices.

17TH CENTURY

By this time, the natural environment was being altered by humans, mostly air and water pollution - and deforestation in Europe.

1800s

The industrial revolution brought an increase in anxiety and discussions about overconsumption of natural resources by scholars and citizens.

POST WWII

The world began facing major environmental issues. The discourse transformed from a focus on pollution to global concern about the survival of the human race, its future generations, and planet.

1970s

The sustainability movement accelerated globally: the first Earth Day, a rise in environmental activism, the first UN conference, and many pieces of legislation. The word *sustainability* began being used, but in many different contexts.

1980s - NOW

The UN Brundtland Commission definition of *sustainable development* became the most regarded in the sustainability movement. Businesses began using *sustainability* as a selling point. But *sustainability* is now used ambiguously and even deceptively, all while climate change worsens.
