has led many proponents of the local food movement to assume local to be synonymous with good. Much of what the local movement stands for does seem to be good or at least better than the alternative of conventional large scale agriculture. But even if local is in many cases better, our use of locality as the standard of goodness narrows the deliberation process, obscuring problems that have emerged within the local movement itself, including but not limited to problems of food access, affordability, and lack of education. There is a need within the local movement of a more rigorous and comprehensive ethical standard than mere locality. This does not mean that we ought to abandon the local food movement altogether; there is much that is of value in the movement we have inherited. Rather, in the spirit of the pragmatic social ethicists John Dewey and Jane Addams, I propose that we have a pressing responsibility to take up the legacy of values we inherit from the local food movement with an active commitment to their growth and expansion. Through inquiry and thoughtful interaction, we might contribute to a resilient and dynamic local food movement that can better address new problems that arise in a changing world.
