Geschiedenis van het boeddhisme: Vanaf het begin tot het verval in India Willem Brownstok, Yuri Galbinst, Tobias Lanslor, Het boeddhisme ontstond in het oostelijke deel van het oude India in en rond het oude koninkrijk Magadha nu in Bihar India en is gebaseerd op de leer van Siddh rtha Gautama De religie evolueerde terwijl deze zich vanuit de noordoostelijke regio van het Indiase subcontinent door Centraal Oost en Zuidoost Azië verspreidde Op een of ander moment heeft het het grootste deel van het Aziatische continent beïnvloed De geschiedenis van het boeddhisme wordt ook gekenmerkt door de ontwikkeling van talrijke bewegingen schisma's en scholen waaronder de Theravada en tradities met contrasterende perioden van expansie en terugtrekking Volgens de vroege bronnen werd Siddh rtha Gautama geboren in de kleine Shakya Pali Sakka Republiek die deel uitmaakte van het Kosala rijk van het oude India nu in het hedendaagse Nepal Hij is dus ook bekend als de Shakyamuni letterlijk De wijze van de Shakya clan De vroege boeddhistische teksten bevatten geen ononderbroken leven van de Boeddha pas later na 200 vGT werden verschillende biografieën met veel mythologische verfraaiing geschreven Alle teksten zijn het er echter over eens dat Gautama afstand deed van het leven van de huisbewoner en enige tijd als sramana asceet leefde en onder verschillende leraren studeerde voordat hij door meditatie nirvana blussen en bodhi ontwaken bereikte The Religions of Tibet Giuseppe Tucci, 2000 Very little is known in the West about Tibetan Buddhism in comparison with other eastern religions This is partly because the vast literature which it has produced and which illuminates its history is still far from accessible In addition there exists a deep division between monastic Lamaism and religion as it is lived by the people the former is fragmented into many schools while the latter shows numerous regional variations The first comprehensive account of Tibetan Buddhism to be published in English since Waddell's Buddhism of Tibet appeared in 1894 this translation is certain to become the standard reference work on the subject The Tibetan Book of the Dead Donald S. Tibetan owing a greater debt to Theosophy and Madame Blavatsky than to the lamas of the Land of Snows Indeed Lopez suggests that the book's perennial appeal stems not only from its origins in magical and mysterious Tibet but also from the way Evans Wentz translated the text into the language of a very American spirituality
