

Ideas and activities for group therapy for substance abuse

The purpose of substance abuse group therapy is to enable the individual to recover to resist drug or alcohol abuse by acquiring a new lifestyle to develop new life skills. New habits and motivation to remain drug or alcohol free are short-term goals for each substance abuse group therapy session.

Break the denial

To break denial, have each group member write a short story of how they began using drugs, including all the details prior to their remission or entry into the substance abuse group therapy process. No member should include their name in the written assignment. The therapist collects the stories and redistributes them so that no one receives their own story. Members read each story aloud, and all members silently raise their hands each time they hear a statement reading that appears to include denial of addiction or the seriousness of the consequences involved.

Using music

Inhibitions in group therapy can be reduced by allowing group members to express their feelings through sharing music. Assign each group member to bring and share at least a single CD that expresses an important aspect of their life or reveals something personal about which they would like to share with the group. Make each moment the members of the group also share the feeling they have experienced expressed in the music.

Throw it away completely

Have each group member write a list of behaviors related to drug or alcohol abuse, along with a list of negative consequences caused by the behaviors. After each behavior and consequence has been shared aloud with the group, place a trash can in the center of the circle and have each member crumple up the lists and physically throw them into the trash can at the front of the group. Each member of the group should verbally release the destructive behavior and consequences completely.

Select one member of the group to play the role of the drug refuser, while other members of the group play the roles of drug dealers, old friends, and family members trying to get the person to recover from drug use again. alcohol in
