Fourteen minutes, 34 seconds, a large degree of skill and a small amount of luck helped win a trip to England for Frank Huffman of Convaair Fort Worth.

An engineering illustrator in preliminary design, Huffman put his drawing and design ability to good use in model plane work. It was good enough to win him a place on the American team that will compete in the World Championship Finals in Cranfield, England in September.

Huffman won his trip to Cranfield staged in Tulsa last month. Before that he won the Fort Worth championship in May.

His time in the semi-final event was 14 minutes and 24 seconds with a good start.

"Perfect weather in Cranfield," Huffman said. "That all went for 13 minutes and 30 seconds, and then three minutes of glide. In a word, you compete like this. You start, you fly, you land in 15, like better your chance of winning."

Huffman didn't leave anything to chance in the Tulsa meet. He took care of his old favorite models with him.

Both planes are designed for windy weather flying. And both were built by Huffman.

The model he took with him was 16 inches long with a 24-inch wing span. He's working on a new and better plane for the world meet.

PBY Project Aide, Jailed in USSR, Finds Asylum in Canada -- at Last

A somewhat happier climax has been reached in the tragic narrative of a Russian who 12 years ago befriended a band of Convaair engineers in the USSR and now is free for all.

It is the tale of Nikolai Ziberko, 44, who survived 27 months of torture and prison, followed by years under German occupation and a decade in displaced persons camps while trying to reach the New World. Thanks in part to the encouragement and financial assistance of Convaair engineers, Ziberko is now in Canada, reunited with his family.

The Convaair men, all of San Diego, are: Garnet Green, now SD chief maintenance engineer; E. A. Reynolds, now manager of long range planning for Aeromasters; Eugene Durney, now SD senior design engineer; Basil Johnson, also SD senior design engineer; Minor Wells, SD assistant project engineer.

It was in 1942 that the Convaair men and their families went to Russia. The task was to help the Russian build PBY's.

"Ziberko was assigned to us as a counselor," Wells recalled last week. "He was a Russian, but he was friendly, helpful, and easy to get along with. He was a good person, and he was a good friend."

Convaair Daingerfield employees now number more than 325—the largest number in the history of Convaair's Daingerfield Division.

"We are not anticipating a reduction in our overall figure in the foreseeable future," said E. Arnold, Convaair Daingerfield Division manager.

The growth in the Daingerfield Aeromaster Laboratory has added 200 employees for about three years, and a large part started around the first of this year.

All the new work developing in recent months has been giving the new facility about all the work it can handle.

To build up the staff, Noble Moore, manager of industrial relations and security, has been recruiting new employees wherever qualified men can be found. Most of them are engineers and skilled technicians, both in short supply.

As Moore pointed out, Convaair Daingerfield is small only when compared with manufacturing facilities.

"When you compare our 200-plus employees with the payroll of other research facilities, it's a really good-sized operation," he observed.

Convaair has operated the Daingerfield Aeromaster since 1945, under contract from the U. S. Navy since 1945. It is located on the Lone Star Road Co. plant in the east Texas "pinny woods."
