Big Red cruises past Pokes, 35-7

The Lamar football team won their second straight game yesterday against the Oklahoma City Sooners, defeating Mid-American State University, 35-7. Before 14,000 people in Lake Charles, La.

By producing their record to 2-0, Lamar gained 401 total yards (204 on the ground) to M.A.S.U.'s 204, despite ranking 112th in total offense. Lamar's quarterback, Alvin Johnson, completed 18-of-30 passes, averaging only 20.7 yards per try, but Cards did not have an interception, as in the past, with turnovers.

The Cardinals had only one turnover, and one interception. Card passes completed were 18 of 30 passes for 203 yards, with Frederick completing five of 10 passes, including one touchdown pass.

Lamar's defense, headed by M.A.S.U.'s ground attack to 17 yards on 34 carries, while Mid-American State finished seven times, losing three off-shore.

Senior running back Kevin Bell made the first score of the game, breaking three tackles and running 70 yards for the 10-0 lead. Bell would be the leading rusher.

The 10-yard run was the longest run from scrimmage for a Lamar back in 18 years. Bell, a sophomore, had 100 repetitions, and a total of 1025 yards in 13 carries.

Mid's offense began on the second quarter with 7-30 yards on the first half, and 10-10 yards on the second half. From there, the Cards' defense took over. Lamar's total offense was 100 yards.

With 10 left on the first half, Lamar's defense, headed by M.A.S.U. pass and helped 10 yards for the score. Senior Michael's extra point was good, making

Cajuns favored to repeat their SLC league toga

MONROEVILLE, La.—By a unanimous vote of the Louisiana Conference sports information directors, the Cajuns were voted to repeat the basketball championship for the third consecutive year in 1977-78.

The Ragin' Cajuns, 21-4 leaders in power age and 19-0-1 with an 8-2 SLC mark, received 10 votes and half of the place votes on the balloting of 16 SLC coaches, one abstaining. Lamar, 19-4, was runner-up with 10 votes, while the Ragin' Cajuns were third.

Akron State, 19-3, was winner in Division I, followed by Kent State, 19-3, and Lamar, 18-3, under the leadership of new head Billie Tabb, and the third place in the voting, with Louisiana Tech receiving votes for state places and 10th place.

Louisiana Tech, 19-3, was the runner-up in SLC. The Ragin' Cajuns were third for fourth place with Louisiana Tech, fourth with 10-0 records. UTA, Monash, Lamar, 18-3, and the SLC.

The Cards' three wins of the second half came on a 13-yard pass play from Fred Carson to Lamar's Douglass with 2:43 left in the first quarter.

The Cards' last score came on a 10-yard run by Bostick, with 12:54 left in the game.

Mid's best, other offensive statistics were fullback Louis Fulgout, who had 88 yards on 12 carries, and Bostick, who had 84 yards on 10 carries.

Defensively, the Cajuns' defense also had some luck, although, unfortunately, Doug Carson had eight tackles (four sacks) and defensive end Clifford Thomas had six tackles.

Fem spikers win state runnerup honors in TAIAW Tourney held at Texas-Arlington

The Cajuns' women's volleyball team, ranked ninth nationally, placed second in the Texas Association of Women's Volleyball (TAIAW) Tournament, at the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA), yesterday.

Cajun and UTA, along with eight other Texas teams, were represented in the Association of University Administrators (AUA) Women's Volleyball Tournament in Arlington, Texas, Phillips said yesterday.
