Weimar Thought, In her article *Method Moment and Crisis in Weimar Science* she voices theoretical and philosophical debates on the implications of science in the Weimar Republic. The last part *Themes of Epoch* tries to fill in the Weimar intelligentsia topics remaining to be discussed: the perception of the East, women and left-wing movements. Finally, the last article of both chapter and book, named *The Aftermath*, presents an interesting analysis of the relationship between National Socialism and the Weimar intelligentsia. The beginning of Carson's *Method Moment and Crisis in Weimar Science* explains the state of Weimar intellectuals and the main theme of the book perfectly: Weimar intellectuals were notoriously riven divided along every possible line. I intend to touch upon three points on *Weimar Thought A Contested Legacy*. Most of the articles in the book retell the development of a discipline, works and/or the life of an important artist or intellectual, or explain a popular movement.
