development lifecycle with the last dregs of the budget in order to meet negligent check box compulsory requirements. Meanwhile adversaries are ever evolving and always just one system away. However defending against such attacks is an increasingly complex prospect The nature of cyberspace ensures that the attacker has the upper hand and can move about with impunity and relative anonymity The sophistication of virulent malware has also made it difficult to detect whether an intrusion has occurred and attackers have a wide range of means at their disposal to gain access to networks even those that are closed Finally bureaucratic and legal barriers can hinder the ability to mount a successful defense Under the current framework different organizations have different responsibilities and different levels of authority when it comes to investigating or defending against intrusions depending on the nature of the attack its geographic origin and the systems it targets In addition there is a need to protect critical government and private sector infrastructure in a way that does not infringe on civil liberties or proprietary data The authors argue that new legislation is needed to establish a more efficient assignment of responsibilities and a revised legal code may be required to successfully defend against the ever evolving cyber threat
