

Ventilator Alarms

Ensure all alarms are set with appropriate parameters each shift!

INCREASED RR RATE

Patient is tiring on a weaning mode or experiencing pain/anxiety

- X Reassess WOB & provide analgesics/sedation
- X Consult RT/MD & consider adjusting mode/PS

APNEA

Patient fails to take spontaneous breath within set interval (usually 20 seconds)

- X Reassess for over sedation & decrease PRN
- X Assess for tiring & consult RT/MD to adjust to full ventilation PRN

LOW EXHALED TV/MV

Patient tiring on weaning mode
ETT cuff or ventilator circuit leak
Pressure limit reached in PC mode

- X Auscultate trachea for cuff leak, check pilot balloon, & add air PRN
- X Check circuit for leaks & tighten all connections
- X Consult RT/MD to increase RR in PC mode if MV is low

HIGH PRESSURE

Coughing, bronchospasms, secretions, pneumothorax
Biting on or kinking of the ETT
Excess water in ETT/circuit

- X Suction patient & remove excess water from tubes
- X Auscultate lungs & provide bronchodilators/order CXR PRN
- X Insert bite block & increase sedation PRN then reassess ETT placement

LOW PRESSURE

Cuff or circuit leak

- X Auscultate trachea for cuff leak, check pilot balloon, & add air PRN
- X Check circuit for leaks & tighten all connections

MANUALLY VENTILATE with a BVM
