Much of what the local movement stands for does seem to be good or at least better than the alternative of conventional large scale agriculture. But even if local is in many cases better, our use of locality as the standard of goodness narrows the deliberation process, obscuring problems that have emerged within the local movement itself, including but not limited to problems of food access, affordability, and lack of education. There is a need within the local movement of a more rigorous and comprehensive ethical standard than mere locality.
