


Study Guide – Reproductive System




Female Reproductive system:

The female reproductive system is made up of the internal and external sex organs that function in reproduction of new offspring. In humans, the female reproductive system is immature at birth and develops to maturity at puberty to be able to produce gametes, and to carry a fetus to full term.

Ovaries:

- Each ovary is about the size and shape of an almond. In young women the ovaries are about 1½-2 inches long, 1-inch-wide & 1/3 inch thick. After menopause they tend to shrink.
- They produce eggs (also called ova) every female is born with a lifetime supply of eggs
