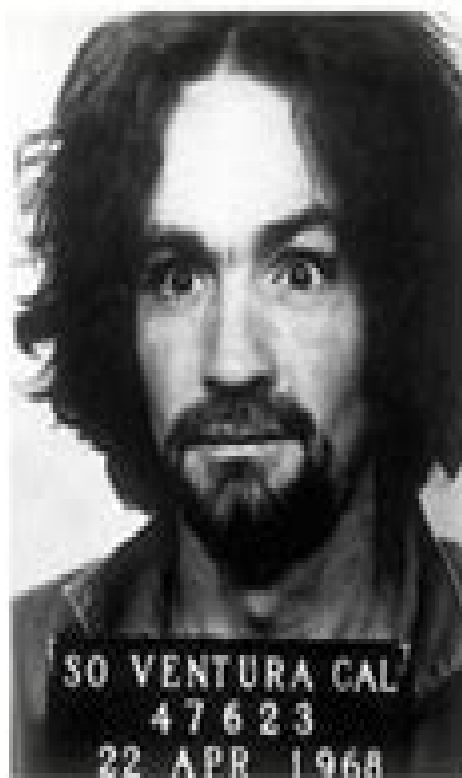

Manson did not directly commit the murder, his ideology constituted an overt act of conspiracy.

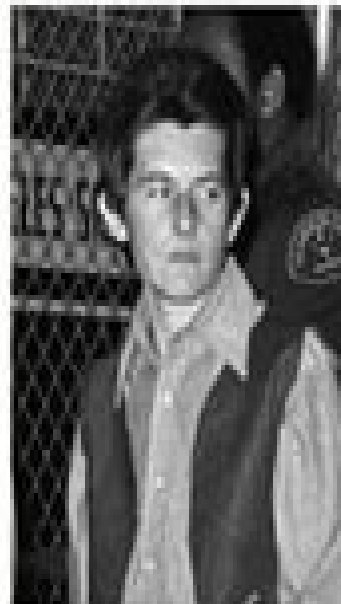
