Dental caries, also known as tooth decay (cavities), is primarily caused by the effects of **plaque** on the surface of the teeth. Plaque consists of a film, living film of **bacterial debris**, **enzymes** and **salivary**. Although having protective features in the cavity, this protect the tooth by neutralizing acids and washing away food particles. Bacterial activity in the plaque can still harm enamel until they gradually destroy the enamel of the tooth. Once a cavity begins, enamel continues into the dentin and if left untreated, to the pulp and nerves of the tooth.

Important: Because early tooth decay (tooth pain) occurs, **regular dental checkups** are important to detect cavities before they develop. Once a cavity is identified, the decayed portion of the tooth is removed with a filling and a crown, if necessary. Tooth decay that has reached the pulp (soft) requires additional treatment, such as pulpotomy and root canal. (See also carotidinal disease.)
