STUDENT FINANCIAL AID (BURSARY) TIPS

1. Ensure you **Remember ALL PASSWORDS** and **DO NOT SHARE PASSWORDS WITH ANYONE**, relating to your **MYNSFAS** profile and your **Coinvest** logins (allowance disbursement profile).
2. To remain updated on bursary related matters, students are urged to make use of the following platforms:
 - * Bursary Office noticeboard located outside, Campus Bursary Office.
 - * Join **PORT Elizabeth College Social media Page** -regular updates posted on College Facebook page (exact search "**PORT Elizabeth TVET College**").
 - * Login to your **Mynsfas** profile regularly.
3. Always disclose to the Bursary Office if you have been offered two bursaries at the same time. **DOUBLE DIPPING IS NOT ALLOWED**- Students cannot be funded by two bursary schemes at the same time.
4. Students with **Disabilities** are urged to disclose their disability when submitting an online application to NSFAS. This will assist, if assistive devices are required etc.
5. **Academic Results** play an important role, whether a student will continue to receive a NSFAS bursary in the future.
6. Students that **have changed contact numbers** – do request the divisional Secretary to update your contact details on the College system and do update your contact details on your Mynsfas profile, this will enable College Staff and NSFAS to get hold of you -if need requires.
7. **Don't divulge personal information to strangers over the phone** – NSFAS and College staff will not contact you and ask for personal information as IDS , address, Passwords etc.
8. If you are not sure about anything relating to your Bursary – Feel free to visit the bursary office at your campus to enquire – Remember staff are there to assist with all bursary related matters.
9. Funding decisions regarding NSFAS bursaries are made in line with NSFAS policy (2023 NSFAS eligibility Criteria and Conditions for Financial Aid) for a copy visit the College website.
10. Students must submit accurate, correct information to NSFAS and College staff as validation checks are prepared on all data supplied. Failure to do so will result in applications being rejected.
