other cases it shows that despite its regular invocation of local ownership discourse the UN operationalizes ownership in restrictive ways that are intended to protect the achievement of operational goals but which consequently limit self determination and increase external imposition on the host country This gap between the rhetoric and reality of ownership suggests that the UN uses local ownership primarily as a discursive tool for legitimation one intended to reconcile conflicting normative and operational imperatives that it faces However because its actions do not match its rhetoric the UN s attempts to generate legitimacy through discourse appear to fall flat particularly in the eyes of local actors and because of contradictions in the ways that the UN operationalizes local ownership it also inhibits the achievement of its operational goals as well
