

The Social Contract Jean-Jacques Rousseau, 1954 In 1762 Rousseau put forward a revolutionary blueprint for a just political community in his compact treatise *On the Social Contract*. This work proclaims that true sovereignty resides not in kings or parliaments but in the united will of the people laying out a vision of collective self-government that would echo through history. Released in 1762, *On the Social Contract* was immediately banned in France and Geneva for its incendiary challenge to the established order. Authorities were alarmed by Rousseau's insistence that legitimate political authority comes only from a social agreement among free citizens rather than from divine right or tradition. The book nonetheless spread across Europe in clandestine editions and would become a foundational text for revolutionaries in France and beyond who drew on its vision of popular sovereignty as they reimagined the principles of government. Composed in a brisk aphoristic style, *On the Social Contract* or *Principles of Political Right* was published in 1762 under a pseudonymous Dutch imprint to evade censorship. It opens with one of Rousseau's most famous declarations: Man is born free and everywhere he is in chains, capturing the idea that modern society has unjustly shackled human liberty. In the chapters that follow, Rousseau sketches how a truly just society could form itself through a social pact. Each person he argues must give up their natural freedom to the community as a whole and in exchange all members receive the protection of laws that express the collective interest. The key to this arrangement is the general will. Rousseau's term for the unified common interest of the people which alone can be sovereign. Government ministers or rulers in his view are merely delegates tasked
