Social disorganization theory states that crime in a neighbourhood is a result of the weakening of traditional social bonds.

SCHOLARLY DEFINITION

"Social disorganization, defined as a sudden influx of a large number of people in and out of a neighborhood, creates a pathological environment that contributes more to crime than the deviant behavior of abnormal individuals." (Shaw & McKay, 1969)

EXAMPLE

Public Housing Projects and Delinquency

Several social disorganization theorists such as Bursik & Grasmick (1993) and Wikstrom & Loeber (2000) concluded that juveniles living in public housing projects in western countries may be more susceptible to crime as the ties of community in such projects are weak.
