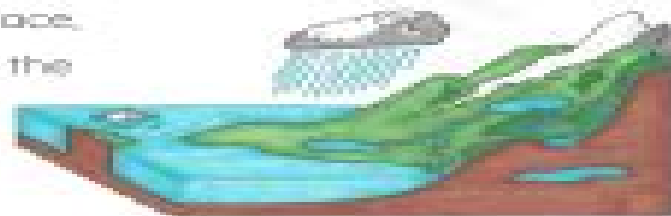


## The water cycle
