### 1. Lamarckism (Theory of Acquired Characters)

Lamarckism was proposed by Jean-Baptiste de Monet, Lamarck in the year 1744-1829. The theory was based on the principle that all the physical changes occurring in an individual during its lifetime are inherited by its offspring. This idea is also called the inheritance of acquired characters. Lamarck based his theory on two observations:

- Individuals have characteristics they do not inherit (i.e. not) and developing characteristics that are passed on.
- Individuals inherit the traits of their ancestors.
