SCORING BREAKDOWN

Each part of the ELA Regents exam is weighted differently, meaning different parts are more important than others.

Multiple Choice = 24 questions x 1 pt. per question = 24 pts.
Argumentative Essay = max score of 6 pts. x 4 = 24 pts.

Thematic Essay = max score of 4 pts. x 2 = 8 pts.

TOTAL POSSIBLE ELA SCORE = 56 pts.

In order to pass, you need a raw score of 29.
(This means you need to do an **effected score** of 85%)

A college-ready raw score is 37.
(This means you need to do an **effected score** of 95%)



GENERAL TIPS!

DO NOT leave any questions blank! If you don't know the answer to a question, just guess! There are NO penalties for incorrect answers.

Start on **arguable** topics (books, topics, & generating and maintaining an idea bank) and **plan** ahead of time rather than last-minute. This is how students **STUDY** for the Regents.

If you have any **HELP** on the ELA, your **parent** or **teacher** is your **best** resource. If you don't know the **topic** you are going to be asked about, **study** with your parents, which is better than reading a chapter.
