Did you know that before the Late 1800s there was no agreed upon time? This meant the length of an hour or when a day began and when it ended varied in different towns and in different countries. This difference in time from town to town didn't really matter when people were mostly farmers and traveled by horse. But when the industrial revolution began and goods were being transported by train, having a standard measure of time became much more important. For example, if a farmer was moving his hay by train from one town to sell in another and he thought it was 9:30 am, but the train conductor thought it was 10:30 am the farmer could miss getting his hay on the train, and being able to sell it in the other town.



To solve this problem in October of 1884, Chester Arthur, the President of the United States, held a conference in Washington D.C that would set a standard time for the entire world. It was decided at the conference that a town in England called Greenwich would be the basis of time for the world and all other countries would base their time zones off of how far they were from Greenwich. There was still one challenge to standardizing time, and that was communicating the time with the world. For this, the invention of the radio was a great help. On this day in 1924 the Greenwich time signal was broadcast on the radio for the first time. This was a series of tones at the beginning of the hour that let everyone listening to the radio set their clocks to the same time.
