HISTORY OF THE WORLD SERIES

Baseball has often been called "America's pastime." For more than one hundred years, fans have cheered for their favorite teams, collected baseball cards, and filled stadiums to watch exciting games. At the end of each Major League Baseball season, the two best teams face off in the World Series, a championship that decides who will be crowned the best in the sport.

The First World Series

The very first World Series was played in 1903. That year, the Boston Americans, who later became known as the Red Sox, played against the Pittsburgh Pirates. The championship was decided by the best of nine games. Instead of the best of seven we know today, Boston won five games, while Pittsburgh won three, making the Boston Americans the first World Series champions.

Fans loved the idea of the World Series, but it didn't happen again in 1904 because one league refused to take part. Luckily, the event returned in 1905 and has been played every year since—except for 1994, when a player strike canceled the season.

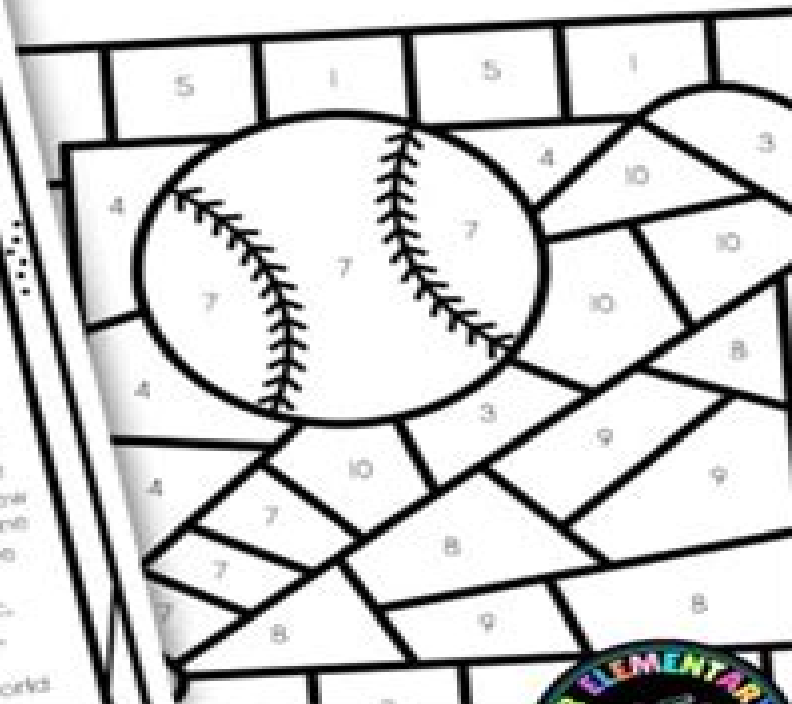
Memorable Moments

The World Series has provided baseball fans with some of the most memorable moments in sports history. In 1925, Babe Ruth, one of the greatest players of all time, made headlines when he was caught trying to throw out the series. In 1956, Don Larsen of the New York Yankees pitched a perfect game in the World Series—the only one in history. In 1980, the Boston Bruins became the first NHL team to win the Stanley Cup, and in 1994, the Los Angeles Dodgers hit a dramatic home run to win the World Series.

In 2003, the Los Angeles Dodgers hit a dramatic home run to win the World Series. In 2004, the Boston Red Sox won the World Series, ending an 86-year drought. In 2005, the Houston Astros won the World Series, becoming the first team to win the World Series in the 21st century. In 2016, the Chicago Cubs won the World Series, ending a 108-year drought.
