Council says

Residents to have say on building

Residents complained that a previous design did not take public opinion into consideration. Members of the City Council voted Monday night that the public will have a say in deciding a proposed school building.

A "citizens" committee will be appointed by other councilmen to propose the public input lacking in the design, which was defeated in the April bond election.

Chairman Tom Feltz, spokesman for the design, has been a city factor with the Colony. He discussed the project, but Monday night's meeting was taken a step closer as the first reading of an ordinance authorizing the city manager to contract for architectural services passed on a unanimous voice vote.

In response to questions about the proposal, City Manager Tom Hart explained that the council will provide the necessary funds and the contractor would be held to a bond election, and that the city would be liable for the services only if the bond were passed. Funds for the school program would come from the contractor. Thus, using the city's facilities would not affect the bond issue price, the spokesman said, with ranges between \$10,000 and \$100,000 plus the cost of any additional accommodations required. The fee would then be paid from bond funds, as a part of the total cost figure.

Proposing a tight time table for putting the proposed together, Hart explained design must be presented immediately should the appointed and designated committee decide "the next couple of weeks." He added that applications from residents willing to serve on the committee are being accepted, but the appointment must be made soon.

In other action, the council issued additional details of the proposed middle school. Hart and Commissioner Hart

Peters announced a joint meeting between Euless and Colony officials on Oct. 24, 1979, and Nov. 14, 1979. According to the original LIDCO plan, which is presently discontinued in part, the LIDCO plan will purchase of the land from Feltz & Associates Inc., then a successor appraiser under which the remaining park land would be developed by the city. The school would utilize city athletic facilities and maintain them in reserve.

Feltz added that the meeting was "highly productive, and the school board has convinced me they are deeply concerned over the schools in the Colony and are determined to meet our needs."

Some concern was voiced over the loss of park land and associated grant funds, but Feltz & Associates has told LIDCO they will reimburse the city approximately \$100,000 to compensate for the loss of grant money.
